Begun as the community sailing arm of the Stonington Harbor Yacht Club in 2002 with 14 boats and a big dream, NESS is now an independent, nationally-recognized, award-winning community program teaching over 3,000 students each year. NESS’s scholarship program and new NESS SEA (STEM Education Ambassador) AmeriCorps program help bring its “hands wet” science and sailing curriculum to students year round.
